HEARING ON HJR 51

Presentation and Opening Statement by Sponsor:

REPRESENTATIVE RICHARD SIMPKINS, House District 39, Great Falls, said HJR 51 is a resolution requesting an interim study of the duties and functions of various educational entities under the Montana Constitution. The Constitution specifically states the Board of Education is responsible for coordinating the activities

between K-12 and higher education throughout Montana. The Constitutional mandate is not being followed.

Proponents' Testimony:

Wayne Buchanan, Board of Public Education said it is easy to see there are governance problems in education. The drafters of the Constitution did not envision the turmoil and confusion under which education operates today. Instead, the Constitution speaks to unified budgets, harmony, and coordination among the various components of educational governance. Today there is a lack of coordination in planning, and dependence by the members of the governance system upon independent elements. A system has developed that is wasteful in terms of dollars, talent, and effort in achieving a workable educational system. The components have become competitive and adversarial. The legislature has the authority and the power to straighten the mess out and HJR 51 is a good start.

Questions From Committee Members:

REP. HARRINGTON asked Wayne Buchanan if this resolution if an attempt by the Board of Education to limit the rule making authority of the Superintendent of Public Instruction. Mr. Buchanan answered no. Under this system there would be increased authority for the Superintendent of Public Instruction.

Closing by Sponsor:

REP. SIMPKINS said the constitutional authority is clearly spelled out. The battlefield for developing the long range plan and system of education should occur on the Board of Education level. Only then will the Legislature have a streamlined plan from which to work.
