- The fund is a party in interest in all proceedings involving workers' compensation claims against an insolvent private self-insurer whose workers' compensation obligations have been paid or assumed by the fund. The fund has the same rights and defenses as the insolvent private self-insurer, including but not limited to all of the following:
  - (a) to appear and deny, defend, and appeal a claim; and
- (b) to receive notice of, investigate, adjust, compromise, settle, and pay a claim.
- (4) The fund shall concur in department decisions relating to allowing an employer to self-insure.""
