#### **HEARING ON HJR 23**

## Presentation and Opening Statement by Sponsor:

Representative Tom Lee, House District 49, presented HJR 23, a joint resolution of the Senate and the House of Representatives of the State of Montana requesting an interim study by the Legislative Branch Computer Systems Planning Council to plan for productive use of computers by legislators.

Representative Lee spoke to the committee about the importance of computer technology and the part it plays in helping produce efficient, economical performance of public duties. Computers have increased the speed and accuracy of legislative work during the past few years. He said that this trend to use computers will only continue to increase.

He spoke to committee about small, powerful, portable computers that could be used by legislators at their desks, during legislative sessions, etc., Some other states are now

using such computers and they are proving to be highly useful and efficient.

Secretary of the Senate, David Hunter, was present. He said that much data processing will be needed for such an operation. He also discussed the possible need for re-wiring the capitol complex for further use of computers in the future.

Chairman Blaylock expressed interest in the possibility of use of portable computers for the legislators. He said that he thought it would require careful planning.

SENATOR DOROTHY ECK made a motion to adopt HJR 23. The vote was unanimous. Motion carried.

# Closing by Sponsor:

Representative Tom Lee assured committee that computers are only going to get better and cheaper. He said that the computer needs of this legislature are relatively simple and he thinks they will be served well with this sort of computer setup.
