Amendment #1- Requested by Representative Bachini and Senator Hockett.

This amendment would move the western boundary of House District 142 in Hill County from the current district boundary to Highway 87 south to just north of Box Elder where it includes a small area west of Hwy 87. The percentage of Native Americans in House District 142 improves slightly to 58.82% of total population and 52.37% of voting age population.
