## EXECUTIVE ACTION ON HOUSE BILL 219

CHAIRMAN GILBERT asked VICE CHAIRMAN FOSTER to assume the chair.

REP. GILBERT said he had been asked by REP. REAM and REP. SHEILA RICE to take HB 219 off the table. The bill allows a tax credit for the conversion of motor vehicles to alternative fuels. The bill would be amended so that the credit would apply only to the conversion unit that is purchased and attached to the vehicle. It also eliminates the corporate credit for installation of alternative fuel refueling stations. He said there is next to no fiscal impact if the amendments are adopted.

Motion: REP. GILBERT MOVED HB 219 BE TAKEN OFF THE TABLE. The motion carried unanimously.

Motion: REP. GILBERT MOVED HB 219 DO PASS.

Motion: REP. GILBERT moved to amend HB 219 as per the attached
standing committee report. EXHIBIT 1

<u>Discussion</u>: REP. NELSON asked if there should be carry back and carry forward provisions in the bill.

Mr. Heiman said that all small tax credit statutes uniformly exclude those provisions.

**Vote**: Motion to adopt the amendments carried unanimously.

Motion: REP. GILBERT MOVED HB 219 DO PASS AS AMENDED.

<u>Discussion</u>: REP. DRISCOLL said he hoped the 1.00 FTE included in the fiscal note has been eliminated by adoption of the amendments.

REP. GILBERT said he hoped the job was eliminated also. He said he will immediately request an updated fiscal note.
