##### Committee Business Summary:

Hearing: None  
Executive Action: HJR 27, SB 378

#### EXECUTIVE ACTION ON HJR 27

Motion/Vote: REP. JOHN JOHNSON moved the Amendments, EXHIBIT 1, REP. MENAHAN seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion: REP. JOHN JOHNSON moved Amendment, EXHIBIT 2.

Discussion: REP. WISEMAN asked what is the status on that action

in the Senate? **CHAIRMAN ZOOK** said they have not taken action yet. The only action he is aware of is they took out the **REP. BERGSAGEL's** amendment on **REP. JOHNSON's** Bill 46.

**Vote:** Motion passed 15 to 3 with Reps. DeBruycker, Fisher and Wiseman voting no.

**Discussion:** **REP. KADAS** referred to Page 4, Line 3 "BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED" and said this way of doing it is out of the ordinary and his concern is they have cut back the number of interim studies they have to such a degree that what they do now the legislative council will combine two, three or four studies and then have one group of people study all those. If we go with this language will preclude that from happening. He thinks they will be better off if they just had the appointment mechanism like they do with other interim studies.

**Motion:** **REP. KADAS** moved amendments to be drafted by Jim Haubein, language to cut back number of studies.

**Discussion:** **REP. JOHN JOHNSON** said that was placed in there to assure a state-wide representation using those four commissioned districts that have been established in SB 36. **REP. KADAS** said he understands that but if you do that it precludes mixing this study with the other studies. There is generally a good attempt made to provide regional distribution on a committee's level of leadership.

**Vote:** Motion carried 14 - 4 with Reps. John Johnson, Kasten, Wanzenried and Wiseman voting no.

**Motion:** **REP. MENAHAN** MOVED HJR DO PASS AS AMENDED.

**Discussion:** **REP. BARDANOUE** asked if Northeast Montana will be represented? **REP. KADAS** said the language was just stricken out.

**REP. ROYAL JOHNSON** asked if they leave in the Bill Page 1, line 24 "serves veterans in northwestern Montana"? Why is northwestern Montana designated? **CHAIRMAN ZOOK** said veterans from anywhere in the state of Montana are able to go to the state veteran's home at Columbia Falls. Purpose of the wording is to show that this part of the state has a veterans' nursing home and the eastern part doesn't.

**REP. MENAHAN** said the majority, or half of the residents basically have been from Missoula to the Northwest, and the other half are scattered throughout the state.

**REP. NELSON** said she didn't like the wording on Page 2, line 6, "some drastic policy decisions" and she would like to change that with an amendment that took out the word "drastic" and put in the word "substantial"

**Motion:** **REP. NELSON** moved to amend HJR 27 to be drafted by Jim

Haubein.

Discussion: REP. JOHN JOHNSON said to strike that whole section because some of those "drastic decisions" are "substantial decisions" so if it could just be left some way so it would indicate some changes are contemplated. REP. NELSON if they wanted to leave it in and then say that "whereas the 1993 Legislature has considered substantial policy decisions".

Vote: Motion carried 17 - 1 with Rep. Royal Johnson voting no.

Discussion: REP. DeBRUYCKER said it has been established that we have had many studies and to cannot see throwing \$40,000 into another study. CHAIRMAN ZOOK said they will all have to be voted on anyway.

Vote: Motion carried 13 - 5 with Reps. Bardanouve, DeBruycker, Fisher, Royal Johnson and Kasten voting no.

EXECUTIVE ACTION ON SB 378

Motion: REP. DeBRUYCKER moved SB 378 DO PASS

Discussion: Jim Haubein, LFA, referred to the fiscal note and said he did talk to Curt Nichols and Terry Cohea and if they strike Section 4 it would be necessary to have general fund appropriated in either HB 667 or HB 2. He asked the question if supplementals would come in there and the answer was no, because a supplemental moves money from the second year of the biennium into the first but there is no general fund money to move here so it would be necessary to add an appropriation to either one of those two Bills if Section 4 is stricken.

REP. KADAS asked if they need to strike Section 4 at all. Is there a reason to do that? The fiscal note seemed to say there was but he did not agree.

SEN. GROSFIELD said the technical note on the fiscal note was taken care of, as he understood it, by the amendment to Section 10 which says Sections 7 - 9 is what Section 4 refers to.

CHAIRMAN ZOOK said Mr. Haubein wonders if it is possible for us to take action and after he visits with Greg Petesch make the necessary changes on the floor.

REP. QUILICI said unless, for some reason, this language has to be stricken, according to the technical note he sees no reason to strike it.

Motion: REP. BERGSAGEL MOVED SB 378 DO PASS AS AMENDED.

Discussion: REP. KADAS said he agrees with REP. QUILICI and he does not see the reason to take it out.


