HEARING ON SJR 30

Opening Statement by Sponsor:

SEN. ETHEL HARDING, Senate District 25, Polson, introduced SJR 30 urging recognition of flag day and the Pause for the Pledge of Allegiance program. She explained the resolution was drafted by high school students under the supervision of the Legislative Council as part of the Pledge of Allegiance program. She said the students contact their senators and representatives to sponsor the resolution.

Questions From Committee Members and Responses:

REP. SPRING asked SEN. HARDING to explain why the resolution was for only two years rather than ongoing. SEN. HARDING explained the resolution is not ongoing because a new group of students would introduce the resolution in the next session.

REP. MASON asked SEN. HARDING whether the reference to mountain standard time should be changed to mountain daylight time. SEN. HARDING said she had not noticed the reference to standard time.

Closing by Sponsor:

SEN. HARDING explained the first student to participate in the Pledge of Allegiance program and go to Baltimore, Maryland, for Flag Day was Suzanne Teichrow, Helena High School, in 1987. She said students from every state go to Baltimore and raise their state flags during the flag ceremonies.
