HEARING ON HJR 32

Opening Statement by Sponsor:

Rep. Dore Schwinden, House District #20, presented HJR 32. HJR 32 is a joint resolution of the Senate and the House commemorating the long and distinguished service of Representative Francis Bardanoue.

Sen. McClernan asked Rep. Schwinden how many signatures were on the resolution and Rep. Schwinden said he had not counted them. Rep. Schwinden stated the House voted unanimously on this resolution.

Sen. Weldon asked Rep. Schwinden if there was a program or a custom by which people are fittingly honored or is it custom-made for this resolution. Rep. Schwinden said there was a similar resolution for Dave Manning who at the time of his retirement was the longest serving legislator in the United States.

Rep. Schwinden stated he had no one designated to carry this resolution on the Senate floor, unless Sen. Hockett, who tacked on the surprise amendment to the Boulder River School to allow for private donations which was the gift that we got for Rep. Bardanouve, wanted to.
