Executive Action: SB 196

EXECUTIVE ACTION ON SENATE BILL 196

Motion: REP. BOB GILBERT moved to reconsider action on SB 196.

<u>Discussion</u>: In response to a question from REP. RANEY, REP. GILBERT said the state would gain by having a one year amnesty period which would allow individuals to remove tanks without registering the tanks. There is still a 48 hour notification period prior to removing the tanks. He added there is a \$50 per year registration fee charged for tanks.

REP. GILBERT added he personally removed a 1,000 gallon tank, which took three months and \$1,400 to complete.

The committee discussed the public perception of fees and the process for tank removal. Previous testimony was reviewed and various scenarios considered. The committee discussed current and alternate procedures at length.

<u>Vote</u>: MOTION TO RECONSIDER SB 196. Motion carried with REPS. RANEY, TOOLE, SWANSON, BROOKE, HARPER and FAGG voting against the motion.

Motion/Vote: REP. HARPER moved to amend the bill on Page 2, line
13, following "tank", Insert: "and the location of the tank,
installation or closure". The motion failed on a 6-4 vote.

Motion/Vote: REP. GILBERT MOVED SB 196 BE CONCURRED IN. The motion carried on a 9-6 roll call vote with REPS. BROOKE, FAGG, HARPER, RANEY, SWANSON, and TOOLE voting against the bill.
