HEARING ON SENATE BILL 53

Opening Statement by Sponsor:

Senator Greg Jergeson, sponsor, said SB 53 would delay the

effective date of the ad hoc supplemental payments to be made to the retirees of the state retirement systems, the teachers' retirement system and the volunteer firefighters' retirement system. He noted there is concern that the effective date is not correct on SB 38, and that SB 53 will show the effective date being July 1, 1995 as was intended in the Senate.

Questions From Committee Members and Responses:

When questioned by Senator Beck regarding passage of SB 38, Senator Jergeson said SB 53 would only be effective if SB 38 passed.

Senator Aklestad questioned the necessity of having this changed.

Senator Jergeson said the legislative auditor expressed concern relative to this. He added in response to a question from Senator Aklestad that as he understands it, the fiscal note for SB 38 is not correct.

Relative to state retirement systems, Senator Jergeson said the bill could be amended so that payments would occur in September. Now the payments would occur in June which would put it in this biennium. He concluded that this is a back-up bill to make sure that the obligation will occur in the next biennium.

Closing by Sponsor:

Senator Jergeson closed on SB 53.
