EXECUTIVE ACTION ON THE ARTS COUNCIL

CHAIRMAN ROYAL C. JOHNSON called the meeting to order. Mr. Bob Tallerico, Legislative Fiscal Analyst, explained that a previous motion on the Arts Council budget which funded one-half of personal services must be re-defined due to insurance coverage limitations with 1/2 time employees.

Motion: REP. RAY PECK MOVED TO RECONSIDER THE MOTION REGARDING FUNDING 1/2 OF NEW PROPOSALS FOR PERSONAL AND OPERATING EXPENSES, ON PAGE E-38.

Vote: THE MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

Motion: SEN. DARYL TOEWS MOVED TO CUT THE ARTS COUNCIL NEW PROPOSALS APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES IN HALF. THIS EQUALS 42,609 IN FISCAL 99 FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES, AND 48,788 IN FISCAL 99 FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES. THE GOVERNOR'S BUDGET OFFICE WOULD THEN MAKE ADJUSTMENTS NEEDED FOR FTE'S INVOLVED.

Vote: THE MOTION PASSED, 5-1.


