<u>Motion/Vote</u>: Rep. Cobb moved to appropriate \$1 million each year for Item 16, Family Preservation Services, as a line item. The motion failed 3-2.

Preservation Services, as written. The motion failed 3-2.

<u>Motion/Vote</u>: Rep. Cobb moved to appropriate \$200,000 each year of the biennium for item 16. The motion failed 3-2.

Motion: Rep. Cobb moved to approve item 17, FAIM Child Care
Support.

<u>Vote</u>: Rep. Cobb's motion to accept item 17 passed 5-1.

Motion: Sen. Swysgood moved to fund 3 day care licensing staff

Those monies that are not expended go into a reserve account. And the Department shall come back next session with a tracking record of this program area.
