HEARING ON THE AGRICULTURAL EXTENSION SERVICE

CHAIRMAN ROYAL JOHNSON called the meeting to order and discussed the hearings scheduled for the day. First on the agenda would be Agricultural Experiment Station and Extension Service followed by Fire Services Training School.

Montana State University (MSU) President Michael Malone offered opening remarks about the agencies associated with MSU, their importance and salary problems. Dr. Joe Chapman, Provost - MSU, discussed the importance of land grants, and the extension offices in serving the needs of the agricultural community.

Dr. Tom McCoy, Dean of Agriculture and Director of the Agricultural Experiment Station, elaborated on the economics generated from the Agriculture field, the funding ratio of State versus private dollars, graduate and undergraduate students served, and future benefits from research programs.
