<u>Motion</u>: Rep. Cobb moved amendment #1 (Exhibit #1), Reduce general fund base \$3 million each year; Department of Public Health and Human Services.

<u>Motion</u>: Rep. Cobb moved to accept amendment #8, Deer Lodge public assistance.

<u>Motion/Vote</u>: Sen. Waterman moved to reconsider child care block grant. The motion passed unanimously.

<u>Motion</u>: Sen. Waterman moved to add Child Care Block Grant funds in '99 biennium, reduce general fund \$19,238, and increase federal Child Care Block Grant \$584,781 (biennial amounts).

<u>Vote</u>: Sen. Waterman's motion on Child Care Block Grant funds passed 5-1.
