LFD staff reviewed Exhibit #1, Reconciliation of Original Executive Budget and Revised Medicaid Projections.

<u>Motion</u>: Rep. Cobb moved to accept revised Medicaid adjustments as prepared by Mike Kenshaw, Administrator, Senior and Long Term Care Division, but keep the reduced Present Law Adjustment--MCBS (previous Subcommittee action) of 10% each year.
