8    BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9            Section 1. Definition of "prime sponsor". As used in  
10    this act, "prime sponsor" means the legislator who first  
11    signs a bill introduced in the legislature.

12           Section 2. Introduction of bills limited. No  
13    legislator may in one session introduce more than five (5)  
14    bills of which he is the prime sponsor. The introduction of  
15    appropriation bills is exempt from the limitation under this  
16    act and shall not be counted against that limitation. A  
17    legislator who has not introduced the five (5) bills to  
18    which he is entitled may introduce a bill as prime sponsor  
19    on behalf of another legislator.
