

# Objection Raised to Adverse Committee Repor 

HOUSE BILL NO. 23
INTRODUCED BY CONROY, LIEN, DAY, DASSINGER, ROBBINS, MANUEL

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT LIMITING TO FIVE (5) THE NUMBER OF BILLS A LEGISLATOR MAY INTRODUCE AS PRIME SPONSOR." BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Definition of "prime sponsor". As used in this act, "prime sponsor" means the legislator who first signs a bill introduced in the legislature.

Section 2. Introduction of bills limited. No legislator may in one session introduce more than five (5) bills of which he is the prime sponsor. The introduction of appropriation bills is exempt from the limitation under this act and shall not be counted against that limitation. A legislator who has not introduced the five (5) bills to which he is entitled may introduce a bill as prime sponsor on behalf of another legislator.
