4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO CODIFY THE SUBSTANCE  
5 OF THE FINAL PLAN OF THE MONTANA DISTRICTING AND  
6 APPORTIONMENT COMMISSION FOR MONTANA CONGRESSIONAL AND  
7 LEGISLATIVE DISTRICTS FILED WITH THE SECRETARY OF THE STATE  
8 PURSUANT TO SECTION 43-117, R.C.M. 1947, AND TO REPEAL  
9 SECTIONS 43-106.6 THROUGH 43-106.9, AND 43-107, R.C.M.  
10 1947."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12 Section 1. Purpose. The legislature intends by this  
13 enactment to codify the substance of the final plan of the  
14 Montana districting and apportionment commission for  
15 reference purposes only. The legislature recognizes the  
16 intent of the 1972 Montana Constitution that the plan filed  
17 with the secretary of state by the commission supercedes any  
18 act of the legislature in conflict with that plan.

19 Section 2. Definitions. For the purposes of this act:

- 20 (1) "C.C.D." means county census division as that term
- 21 is used by the bureau of the census of the U.S. department
- 22 of commerce.
- 23 (2) "Co." means county.
- 24 (3) "E.D." means enumeration district as that term is
- 25

1 used by the bureau of the census of the U.S. department of  
2 commerce.

3 (4) "Plan" means the final plan of the districting and  
4 apportionment commission.

5 Section 3. Number of senators and representatives.  
6 The plan provides for a senate consisting of fifty (50)  
7 members and a house of representatives consisting of one  
8 hundred (100) members.

9 Section 4. Senatorial districts. The plan established  
10 fifty (50) single member senatorial districts constituted as  
11 follows:

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:  
Section 1--Purpose--The legislature intends by this enactment to codify the substance of the final plan of the Montana districting and apportionment commission for reference purposes only. The legislature recognizes the intent of the 1972 Montana Constitution that the plan filed with the secretary of state by the commission supercedes any act of the legislature in conflict with that plan.  
Section 2--Definitions--For the purposes of this act:
