
A BILL FOR AN ACT EATITLED: "AN ACT TO CODIFY THE SUBSTANCE OF THE FINAL PLAN OF THE HONTANA DISTRECTING AND APPORTIONTENT COMMISSION FOR MONTANA CONGRESSIONAL AND LEGISLATIVE DISTRICTS FILED mith the secretary of the smate PURSUANT TO SECTION 43-117, E.C.M. 1947, AND TO REPEAL SECTIONS 43-106.6 THROUGH 43-106.9, AND 43-107, F.C.C. 1947." BE IT ENACTED EY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NONTANA:
Section 1. Purpose. The legislature intends by this enactment to codify the substance of the final plan of the Vontana districting snd apportionment commission for reference purposes only. The legislature recognizes the intent of the 1972 Montana Constitution that the plan filed with the secretary of state by the comission supercedes any act of the leqislature in conflict with that plan.
section 2. Definitions. For the purposes of this act:
(1) "c.e. ." means county census division as that tera is used by the bureau of the census of the fr. S. departent of. conmerce.
(2) "Co." means county.
(3) "E.D." means enumeration district as that term is
used by the bureau of the census of the U.S. department of commerce.
(4) "Plan" means the final. plan of the districting and apportionment commission

Section 3: Number of senators and representatives. The plan provides for a senate consisting of fifty (50) members and a house of representatives consisting of one hundred (l00) members.

A Bill for an act entitled: wan act to codify the substance OF THE FINAL PLAN OF THE MONTANA DISTRICTING AND APPORTIONMENT COMMISSION FOR MONTANA CONGRESSIONAL AND LEGISLATIVE DISTRICTS FILED WITH THE SECRETARY OF THE STATE PURSUANT TO SECTION 43-117, R.C.M. 1947, AND TO REPEAL SECTIONS 43-106.6 THROUGH 43-106.9, AND 43-107. R.C.K. 1947."
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
Section 1. Purpose. The legislature intends by this enactment to codify the substance of the final plan of the Montana districting and apportionment commission for reference purposes only. The legislature recognizes the intent of the 1972 Montana Constitution that the plan filed with the secretary of state by the comission supercedes any act of the legislature in conflict with that plan.

## Section 2. Definitions. For the purposes of this act:

(1) "C.C.D." means county census division as that tern is used by the bureau of the census of the f.3. department of commerce.
(2) "Co." means county.
(3) "E.D." means entmeration district as tinat terr : s
used by the bureau of the census of the U.S. department of commerce.
(4) "Plan" means the final plan of the districting and apportionment commission.

Section 3. Number of senators and representatives. The plan provides for a senate consisting of fifty (50) members and a house of representatives consisting of one hundred (100) members.

follous: The counties of Beaverhead, Broadwater, Deer Lodge, Flathead, Gallatin, Granite, Jefferson, Lake, Levis and Clark, Lincoln, Kadisen, Kineral, Vissoula, Powell, Ravalli, Sanders, Silver Bow, Glacier, Toole, Liberty, Pondera, Meagher, and Park constitute the first congressional district of the state. The counties of Big Horn, Blaine, Carbon, Carter, Cascade, Chouteau, Custer, Daniels, Dawson, Fallon, Fergus, Garfield, Golden Valley, Hill, Judith Basin, McCone, Musselshell, Fetroleum, Phillips, Powder River, Prairie, Richland, Rosebua, Roosevelt, Sheridan, Stillwater, Sweet Grass, Teton, Treasure, Valley, Wheatland, Wibaux and Yellowstone constitute the second congressional district of the state.
