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A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT ALLOWING A THIRD CLASS CITY TO RETAIN THE COUNTY ATTORNEY FOR LEGAL MATTERS NOT INVOLVING A CONFLICT OF INTEREST; AMENDING SECTION 11-702, P.C.M. 1947."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
Section 1. Section 11-702, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to read as follows:

"11-702. Officers of city of second and third classes. The officers of a city of the second and third classes consist of one mayor, two aldermen from each ward, one police judge, one city treasurer, who may be ex officio tax collector, who must be elected by the qualified electors of the city as hereinafter provided. There may also be appointed by the mayor, with the advice and consent of the council, one city clerk, who is ex officio city assessor, one chief of police, one city attorney, and any other officer necessary to carry out the provisions of this title. The city council may prescribe the duties of all city officers, and fix their compensation, subject to the limitations contained in this title. A third class city may retain the county attorney to provide legal services for the

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city in cases not involving a conflict between the interests of the city and the county."
