4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO REQUIRE PHARMACIES OF TO POST THE PRICES OF PRESCRIPTION DRUGS UNDER CERTAIN MARK

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Prescription drug list -- price quotations -- associated services. (1) In every pharmacy there shall be posted on the premises in a place conspicuous to customers a list, provided by the department of professional and occupational licensing. of the one hundred prescription drugs most frequently sold in this state, and the professional services and nonprofessional convenience services associated with the dispensing of drugs as specified by the department. The list shall be of uniform style and size, no smaller than seventeen (17) inches wide by twenty-eight (28) inches high, and shall provide space for the insertion of retail price charged in the pharmacy for the three (3) quantities most frequently dispensed in this state, as determined by the department, of each of the designated drugs, and provide space for the pharmacy to indicate the professional services and nonprofessional convenience services which are provided or not provided by the pharmacy as part of the retail price charged for the drug. The list shall be completed and posted by every pharmacy in accordance with regulations adopted by the department, and shall be revised annually on dates specified by the department as the department shall direct.

(2) A pharmacist, or his employee, upon request, however communicated to him, shall give the current retail price for any drug sold at the pharmacy, including those posted pursuant to subsection (1) above.

10 (3) This section shall not apply to a pharmacy,
11 located in a licensed hospital, which is accessible only to
12 hospital medical staff and personnel.
