CONCLUSION:

Since the Legislature will meet in FY 77 regardless of voter approval of House Bill 44, there would actually be a decrease in expenditures in this biennium due to length of sessions. However, since the Legislature would meet in 1978 if the proposed bill were ratified, the effect over a two-year period would be an increase in expenditures of \$150,000. In addition to the increase in assembly costs, increase in expenses due to annual sessions, such as printing House and Senate Journals and session laws, are estimated at \$80,000 over a two-year period.
