INTRODUCED BY Sales Subing

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE GOVERNING BODY OF A COUNTY TO MAKE AN ALL-PURPOSE ANNUAL MILL LEVY IN LIEU OF THE MULTIPLE LEVIES AND ESTABLISHING A MAXIMUM NUMBER OF MILLS."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Purpose. It is the purpose of this act to authorize and empower the governing body of a county, at its option, to make an all-purpose annual mill levy in lieu of the multiple levies now authorized by the statutes of the state of Montana. The all-purpose mill levy may not include the levies imposed for bond sinking and interest funds, poor fund, emergency fund, or any levies not countywide, or to pay judgments, which levies may be made in addition to the all-purpose levy.

Section 2. All-purpose levy. The various county governing bodies of the state of Montana may make an all-purpose annual levy upon the assessed value of all the taxable property in such county for county purposes, in lieu of the multiple levies authorized. The total of such all-purpose levy may not exceed sixty-five (65) mills on the dollar, which shall not include any levies necessary for

bond sinking and interest fund, poor fund, emergency fund, or any levies not countywide, or to pay judgments.

3 Section 3. General purpose fund. The monies received 4 from such all-purpose levy shall be accounted for in a

common fund known as the general purpose fund.

Section 4. Fund for capital improvements. An amount not to exceed five percent (5%) of the monies received from and as part of the all-purpose levy may be placed in a separate fund to be earmarked for the replacement and acquisition of property, plants, or equipment costing in excess of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) with a life expectancy of five (5) years or more; provided that a capital improvement program has been formally adopted by board resolution. Any interest earned on the capital

Section 5. Appropriations. Any county making an all-purpose annual mill levy shall make appropriations to the several departments of the county in its annual budget and appropriation resolution, or in any other legal manner as the county governing body shall determine suitable.

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Section 5. Levies not countywide. Authorized levies
to pay for bond sinking and interest fund, poor fund,
emergency fund, or levies not countywide, or to pay
judgments, may be made by counties in addition to such

- Section 7. Construction of act. This act shall not be
- 3 construed as repealing those statutes providing for multiple
- 4 separate levies.
