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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

16 Section 1. Section 75-5607, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to 17 read as follows:

"75-5607. Powers and duties. The board of education shall have the power and it shall be its duty to:

- (1) effect an orderly and uniform system of teacher certification and for the issuance of an emergency authorization of employment by adopting the policies prescribed by sections 75-6002 and 75-6011;

- 13 (6) adopt policies prescribing the conditions when 14 school may be conducted on Saturday, and the types of 15 pupil-instruction-related days and approval procedure for 16 such days in accordance with the provisions of sections 17 75-7404 and 75-7405:
- 1.8 (7) adopt standards of accreditation and establish the 19 accreditation status of every school in accordance with the 20 provisions of sections 75-7501 and 75-7502:
- 21 (3) establish the scope of conservation education in 22 the schools in accordance with the provisions of section 75-7509:
- 24 (9) approve or disapprove educational media selected by the superintendent of public instruction for the

- educational media library in accordance with the provisions of section 75-7511;
 - (10) as the governing board of the state of Montana for vocational education, adopt the policies prescribed by and in accordance with the provisions of section 75-7702;
 - (11) consider applications for post-secondary vocational-technical center designation in accordance with the provisions of section 75-7707:

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- (12) for the purposes of post-secondary vocational-technical centers, approve or disapprove programs and budgets, direct the distribution of moneys in support of such budgets, determine tuition rates and fees, enter into lease agreements or real property purchases in accordance with the post-secondary vocational-technical center provisions of the vocational education chapter of this Title;
- (13) adopt policies for the conduct of special education in accordance with the provisions of section 75-7802:
- 20 (14) supervise community college districts in 21 accordance with the provisions of sections 75-8103 and 22 75-8119;
- 23 (15) call an election, determine the results of the 24 election, order and implement the organization of a 25 community college district in accordance with the community

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- 2 (16) approve all rules or regulations and changes
 3 therein promulgated by an association or organization whose
 4 purpose is to regulate inter-scholastic activity involving

- 6 (17) review quarterly the financial statements, and

 8 attempting to regulate inter-scholastic activity involving
 9 public schools;
- 10 (18) appoint two (2) members to serve as members with
 11 full privileges on the board of directors or board of
 12 control of an association or organization whose purpose is
 13 to regulate inter-scholastic activity involving public
 14 schools, and
 - (16) (19) perform any other duty prescribed from time to time by this Title or any other act of the legislature."

 Section 2. Section 75-5707, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to read as follows:
 - "75-5707. Powers and duties. The superintendent of public instruction shall have the general supervision of the public schools and districts of the state, and he shall have the power and shall perform the following duties or acts in implementing and enforcing the provisions of this Title:

- 15 (6) prescribe absentee voting forms and rules in 16 accordance with the provisions of section 75-6416;
- 17 (7) approve or disapprove the orders of a high school 18 boundary commission in accordance with the provisions of 19 section 75-6528:
 - (8) approve or disapprove the opening or reopening of a school in accordance with the provisions of sections 75-6602, 75-6603, 75-6604, or 75-6605;
- 23 (9) approve or disapprove school isolation within the 24 limitations prescribed by section 75-6693;
- 25 (10) generally supervise the school budgeting

procedures prescribed by law in accordance with the provisions of section 75-6702, and prescribe the school budget format in accordance with the provisions of section sections 75-6704 and 75-7209;

- 5 (11) establish a system of communication for 6 calculating joint district revenues in accordance with the 7 provisions of section 75-6721;
- 8 (12) approve or disapprove the adoption of a 9 district's emergency budget resolution under the conditions 10 prescribed in section 75-6725, and publish rules and 11 regulations for an application for additional state aid for 12 an emergency budget in accordance with the approval and 13 disbursement provisions of section 75-6729;
 - (13) generally supervise the school financial administration provisions as prescribed by section 75-6802;

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- (14) appoint the responsible county officials for the performance of the budgeting duties and the financial administration duties for a joint district in accordance with the provisions of sections 75-6700 and 75-6803;
- (15) prescribe and furnish the annual report forms to enable the districts to report to the county superintendent in accordance with the provisions of subsection (5) of section 75-6006, and the annual report forms to enable the county superintendents to report to the superintendent of public instruction in accordance with the provisions of

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- (16) approve, disapprove or adjust an increase of the average number belonging (ANB) in accordance with the provisions of sections 75-6903 and 75-6904;
- 5 (17) distribute state equalization aid in support of 6 the foundation program in accordance with the provisions of 7 sections 75-6968, 75-6918, and 75-6919:
- 8 (18) estimate the state-wide equalization level for 9 the foundation program in accordance with the provisions of 10 section 75-6920:
- 11 (19) distribute state impact aid in accordance with 12 the provisions of section 75-6925;
- 13 (20) provide for the uniform and equal provision of 14 transportation by performing the duties prescribed by the provisions of section 75-7005; 15
- 16 (21) approve or disapprove an adult education program for which a district proposes to levy a tax in accordance 17 18 with the provisions of section 75-7207;
- (22) request, accept, deposit and expend federal 19 20 moneys in accordance with the provisions of section 75-7303;
- (23) authorize the use of federal moneys for the 21 22 support of an interlocal co-operative agreement in 23 accordance with the provisions of sections 75-7306 and
- 24 75-7307:
- 25 (24) prescribe the form and contents of and approve or

- 1 disapprove interstate contracts in accordance with the provisions of section 75-7308;
- 3 (25) approve or disapprove the conduct of school on a Saturday or on pupil-instruction-related days in accordance with the provisions of sections 75-7404 and 75-7405;
- 6 (26) recommend standards of accreditation for all schools to the board of education, and evaluate compliance 8 with such standards and recommend accreditation status of 9 every school to the board of education in accordance with 10 the provisions of sections 75-7501 and 75-7502;
- 11 (27) collect and maintain a file of curriculum guides 12 and assist schools with instructional programs in accordance 13 with the provisions of sections 75-7505 and 75-7506;
- 14 (28) recommend the scope of conservation education in 15 the schools to the board of education in accordance with the provisions of section 75-7509: 16
- 17 (29) establish and maintain a library of visual, 18 aural, and other educational media in accordance with the 19 provisions of section 75-7511;
- 20 (30) license textbook dealers, maintain a textbook 21 library, initiate prosecution of textbook dealers violating 22 the law, and supply a textbook listing in accordance with 23 the provisions of the textbooks chapter of this Title;
- 24 (31) administer and perform the duties as the 25 executive officer of the board of education for vocational
