#### DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 78 requires first and second class cities to pay the full premium for firefighters insurance, to provide firefighters a minimum of \$20,000 life insurance, and provide authority to raise the local mill levy, not to exceed two mills.

## **ASSUMPTIONS:**

- 1. 400 firemen will be affected.
- 2, \$20,000 life insurance coverage costs \$12 per month per fireman.
- 3. Firemen's group hospitalization, medical, and health accident insurance premiums are \$55 per month per fireman.
- 4. Total taxable valuation of first and second class cities in FY 75 was \$270,737,543. It is assumed this value will not change significantly during the biennium.
- 5. There would be no impact on state expenditures under proposed law.

## LOCAL FISCAL IMPACT:

Expenditures of first and second class cities will increase by an estimated \$328,000 per year. An additional local property tax levy of 1,21 mills would cover the increased expenditure.
