Any information obtained by the board or by the 20 director or his staff by virtue of applications for licenses 21 or permits is, however, properly admissible in any hearing 22 conducted by the director, the board, appeals board or in 23 any judicial proceeding to which the director and the 24 25 applicant are parties.
