9 Section 1. Section 53-1107, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to

11 "53-1107. Repairs to substandard vehicles--fee paid to
12 Department by inspection stations. In the event repair or
13 adjustment of any vehicle or its equipment is found
14 necessary upon inspection, the owner of said vehicle may
15 obtain such repair or adjustment at any place he may choose,
16 within fifteen (15) days, but in every event an official
17 certificate of inspection and approval shall be obtained
18 from an official inspection station within fifteen (15) days
19 after the initial inspection and before such vehicle shall
20 be operated upon the highways of this state. The fee shall
21 be collected at the time of the original inspection. No
22 additional fee shall be charged if the vehicle is repaired
23 and returned to the same inspection station within fifteen
24 (15) days.

25 A fee of one dollar and twenty-five cents (\$1.25) shall

1 be collected from each official inspection station for each
2 certificate of inspection, ~~and said fee to be paid into the~~
3 ~~state-highway fund.~~ A refund shall be made, or credit
4 allowed, for unused certificates of inspection, or for
5 certificates lost, mutilated or destroyed, to the extent
6 provided by the department.

7 Section 2. Earmarked account for vehicle inspection.
8 There is created a vehicle inspection account in the
9 earmarked revenue fund. The department of justice shall
10 deposit fees collected under section 53-1107 into this
11 account. The account is assigned to the department of
12 justice for the purpose of administering vehicle inspection
13 statutes.

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT AMENDING SECTION 53-1107, R.C.M. 1947, AND ESTABLISHING A VEHICLE INSPECTION ACCOUNT IN THE EARMARKED REVENUE FUND."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 53-1107, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to read as follows:

"53-1107. Repairs to substandard vehicles--fee paid to department by inspection stations. In the event repair or adjustment of any vehicle or its equipment is found necessary upon inspection, the owner of said vehicle may obtain such repair or adjustment at any place he may choose, within fifteen (15) days, but in every event an official certificate of inspection and approval shall be obtained from an official inspection station within fifteen (15) days after the initial inspection and before such vehicle shall be operated upon the highways of this state. The fee shall be collected at the time of the original inspection. No additional fee shall be charged if the vehicle is repaired and returned to the same inspection station within fifteen (15) days.

A fee of one dollar and twenty-five cents (\$1.25) shall

be collected from each official inspection station for each certificate of inspection~~7--said--fee--to-be-paid-into-the state-highway-fund.~~ A refund shall be made, or credit allowed, for unused certificates of inspection, or for certificates lost, mutilated or destroyed, to the extent provided by the department.

Section 2. Earmarked account for vehicle inspection. There is created a vehicle inspection account in the earmarked revenue fund. The department of justice shall deposit fees collected under ~~section~~ SECTIONS 53-1107 AND 53-1103 into this account. The account is assigned to the department of justice for the purpose of administering vehicle inspection statutes."
