In compliance with a written request received <u>January 24</u>, 19<u>75</u>, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for <u>House Bill 112</u> pursuant to Chapter 53, Laws of Montana, 1965 - Thirty-Ninth Legislative Assembly. Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act to raise the minimum salary of firemen in first and second class cities to \$750 per month from \$600 per month and to delete the maximum of 20 years service for percentage increase.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. Increasing firemen's salaries from a minimum of \$600 per month plus \$6 per month for each additional year of service to \$750 per month plus \$7.50 per month for each additional year of service will result in a salary increase of 25% for every fireman who started at the minimum salary of \$600 per month.

2. Those cities paying a starting salary above the \$600 current minimum will continue to pay proportionately more than the proposed minimum. In other words, the 25% salary increase will apply to all firemen.

3. Total salaries for firemen in first and second class cities will be \$4,300,000 in FY 76 and \$4,330,000 in FY 77 under current law.

4. House Bill 112 will have no impact on state expenditures.

CONCLUSION:

Enactment of House Bill 112 would result in a maximum increase in expenditures of \$2,157,500 during the biennium for the thirteen first and second class cities.
