 4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT CHANGING MEMORIAL DAY
 5 FROM THE LAST MONDAY IN MAY TO MAY 30; AMENDING SECTION
 6 19-107, R.C.M. 1947."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 Section 1. Section 19-107, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to
 10 read as follows:

11 "19-107. Legal holidays and business days defined. The
 12 following are legal holidays in the state of Montana:

- 13 (1) Each Sunday.
- 14 (2) New Year's Day, January 1.
- 15 (3) Lincoln's Birthday, February 12.
- 16 (4) Washington's Birthday, the third Monday in
 17 February.
- 18 (5) Memorial Day, ~~the last Monday in~~ May 30.
- 19 (6) Independence Day, July 4.
- 20 (7) Labor Day, the first Monday in September.
- 21 (8) Columbus Day, the second Monday in October.
- 22 (9) Veterans' Day, November 11.
- 23 (10) Thanksgiving Day, the fourth Thursday in November.
- 24 (11) Christmas Day, December 25.
- 25 (12) State general election day. If any of the

1 above-enumerated holidays (except Sunday) fall upon a
 2 Sunday, the Monday following is a holiday. All other days
 3 are business days.

4 Whenever any bank in the state of Montana elects to
 5 remain closed and refrains from the transaction of business
 6 on Saturday, pursuant to authority for permissive closing on
 7 Saturdays by virtue of the laws of the state, legal holidays
 8 for such bank during the year of such election are hereby
 9 limited to the following holidays:

- 10 (1) Each Sunday.
- 11 (2) New Year's Day, January 1.
- 12 (3) Memorial Day, ~~the last Monday in~~ May 30.
- 13 (4) Independence Day, July 4.
- 14 (5) Labor Day, the first Monday in September.
- 15 (6) Thanksgiving Day, the fourth Thursday in November.
- 16 (7) Christmas Day, December 25.
- 17 (8) On such days as banks are closed in accordance
 18 with sections 5-1058 to 5-1062. Any bank practicing
 19 Saturday closing in compliance with law may remain closed
 20 and refrain from the transaction of business on Saturdays,
 21 notwithstanding that a Saturday may coincide with a legal
 22 holiday other than one of the holidays designated above for
 23 banks practicing Saturday closing in compliance with law,
 24 and provided further that it shall be optional for any bank,
 25 whether practicing Saturday closing or not, to observe as a

1 holiday and to be closed on any day upon which a general
2 election is held throughout the state of Montana and on
3 Veterans' Day, November 11, and on any local holiday which
4 historically or traditionally or by proclamation of a local
5 executive official or governing body is established as a day
6 upon which businesses are generally closed in the community
7 in which the bank is located."
