Whenever any bank in the state of Montana elects to remain closed and refrains from the transaction of business 5 6 on Saturday, pursuant to authority for permissive closing on 7 Saturdays by virtue of the laws of the state, legal holidays for such bank during the year of such election are hereby 8 limited to the following holidays: 9 10 (1) Each Sunday. 11 (2) New Year's Day, January 1. 12 Memorial Day, the-last-Monday-in May 30.
