Section 1. There is a new R.C.M. section numbered  
95-2206.5 that reads as follows:

95-2206.5. Special mandatory sentence -- negligent  
homicide. When a person is convicted of the offense of  
negligent homicide where there is a finding that the  
defendant was driving while intoxicated the sentencing  
judge, with concurrence of the respective county sheriff,  
shall suspend the sentence imposed upon the defendant for  
jail base release or prison furlough purposes. If the  
defendant violates his release, any lapsed time, except jail  
time, is not a credit against the sentence, unless the court  
shall otherwise order.
