A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE SALE OF THE OLD PRISON SITE AT DEER LODGE TO THE CITY OF DEER LODGE FOR ONE DOLLAR (\$1)."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Sale of old prison site. To preserve and enhance the cultural, educational, recreational, and scenic values of the old prison site at Deer Lodge, Montana, the state board of land commissioners is authorized and directed to transfer the site by warranty deed to the city of Deer Lodge for consideration of one dollar (\$1).

For purposes of this act, the old prison site at Deer Lodge is described as follows:

"Blocks 52, 53, 62, 63, 66 and 67 of the Original Townsite to the City of Deer Lodge, according to the official map of the City of Deer Lodge, approved and accepted by the City Council on the 26th day of February, 1912."

15 IS VACATED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF INSTITUTIONS.

16 For purposes of this act, the old prison site at Deer
17 Lodge is described as follows:

18 "Blocks 52, 53, 62, 63, 66 and 67 of the Original
19 Townsite to the City of Deer Lodge, according to the
20 official map of the City of Deer Lodge, approved and
21 accepted by the City Council on the 26th day of February,
22 1912."
