4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION  
 5 11-1024, R.C.M. 1947, TO EXCLUDE CONFIRMED FIREFIGHTERS OF  
 6 CITIES OF THE FIRST AND SECOND CLASS FROM THE TEN DOLLAR  
 7 LIMITATION."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 Section 1. Section 11-1024, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to  
 11 read as follows:

12 "11-1024. Group insurance for all departments,  
 13 bureaus, boards, commissions and agencies of the state of  
 14 Montana, county, city, and town officers and  
 15 employees--authority--approval of employees--limit on  
 16 contributions. All departments, bureaus, boards, commissions  
 17 and agencies of the state of Montana, and all counties,  
 18 cities and towns shall upon approval by two-thirds (2/3)  
 19 vote of the officers and employees of each such department,  
 20 bureau, board, commission, agency, county, city and town,  
 21 enter into group hospitalization, medical, health including  
 22 long-term disability, accident and/or group life insurance  
 23 contracts or plans for the benefit of their officers,  
 24 employees and their dependents, and the respective  
 25 administrative and governing bodies shall pay for such

1 insurance ten dollars (\$10) per month for each officer and  
 2 employee, and provided for employees of educational  
 3 institutions whose employment contracts show at a minimum a  
 4 full-time academic year of employment such payment for  
 5 insurance may be an amount equal to twelve (12) times the  
 6 monthly rate, but may not exceed one hundred twenty dollars  
 7 (\$120) per year. Provided, however, that for employees of  
 8 elementary and high school districts and confirmed  
 9 firefighters, of cities and towns of the first and second  
 10 class, premium contributions are not subject to the ten  
 11 dollar (\$10) limitation of this section."
