 2 INTRODUCED BY Menahan

 4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT ESTABLISHING A SEPARATE  
 5 SALARY SCHEDULE FOR THE OFFICE OF COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER;  
 6 AMENDING SECTION 25-605, R.C.M. 1947."

7  
 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 Section 1. There is a new R.C.M. section numbered  
 10 25-605.1 that reads as follows:

11 25-605.1. The salary of a county clerk and recorder  
 12 shall be based on the population and taxable valuation of  
 13 the county in accordance with the following schedule. The  
 14 total salary paid to a county clerk and recorder shall be  
 15 the sum of the salary shown in column A added to the salary  
 16 shown in column B. A county clerk and recorder serving as  
 17 ex officio registrar and election supervisor is entitled to  
 18 receive, in addition to the salary, a sum equivalent to one  
 19 (1) month's salary in any year in which a general election  
 20 is held.

4 Section 2. Section 25-605, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to  
 5 read as follows:

6 "25-605. Salaries of certain county officers. The  
 7 salaries of county treasurers, ~~clerk-and-recorder~~, clerk of  
 8 the court, county attorneys, sheriffs, county  
 9 superintendents of schools, and of county surveyors in  
 10 counties where county surveyors now receive salaries as  
 11 provided in section 16-3302, shall be based on the  
 12 population and taxable valuation of the county in accordance  
 13 with the following schedule:

22 The total salary paid to county treasurers, ~~clerk-and~~  
 23 ~~recorder~~, clerk of the court, county attorneys, sheriffs,  
 24 county superintendents of schools and county sheriffs, and  
 25 county surveyors in counties where county surveyors receive

1 salaries, as provided in section 16-3302, shall be the sum  
2 of the salary shown in column A based on population when  
3 added to the salary shown in column B based on taxable  
4 valuation; provided, however, that county superintendent of  
5 schools shall receive, in addition to the salary based upon  
6 the totals of columns A and B above, the sum of four hundred  
7 dollars (\$400) per year and county sheriffs and county  
8 attorneys shall receive, in addition to the salary based  
9 upon the totals of columns A and B above, the sum of one  
10 thousand two hundred dollars (\$1,200) per year.  
11 Notwithstanding the above, in each county with a population  
12 in excess of thirty thousand (30,000) the county attorney  
13 shall receive a salary of sixteen thousand dollars (\$16,000)  
14 per year."
