BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 66-1316, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to
read as follows:

"66-1316. Act not to apply to physicians and surgeons
or optometrists. Nothing in this act shall be construed to
apply to physicians and surgeons authorized to practice
under the laws of the state of Montana nor to an optician
performing the required mechanical work under an order or
prescription signed by a duly licensed physician, ~~or~~
surgeon, or optometrist, nor to commissioned officers of the
armed forces of the United States performing functions of
this act in the line of their regular duty, nor to persons
who sell spectacles or eyeglasses without attempting to
traffic upon assumed skill in adapting them to the eye."
