A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PROVIDE LIABILITY INSURANCE FOR PRIVATELY OWNED VEHICLES OF PROBATION OFFICERS WHEN USED ON OFFICIAL BUSINESS."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Liability insurance for probation officers. The board of county commissioners shall provide liability insurance for not more than one (1) privately owned vehicle used by the chief probation officer, not more than one (1) privately owned vehicle used by the chief deputy probation officer, and not more than one (1) privately owned vehicle used by each deputy probation officer when the vehicles are used on official business. This insurance shall be paid from county funds and it shall provide full comprehensive and collision coverage plus minimum coverage of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for each person for bodily injury and medical expenses, three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for all persons per accident, and fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) per accident for property damage. This section shall not apply to counties furnishing motor vehicles to the juvenile probation department.
