A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REQUIRING THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO MAINTAIN AN INVENTORY OF PUBLIC 5 ROADS IN THE COUNTY."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 32-2801, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to read as follows:

"32-2801. Powers and duties of county commissioners respecting county roads. (1) Each board of county commissioners has general supervision over the county roads within the county. The board may, in its discretion, divide the county into suitable road districts, and place each district in charge of a competent road supervisor. The board shall order and direct each supervisor in the work to be done in his district. If the board does not divide the county into districts, the county itself shall constitute one road district.

- (2) Each board shall survey, view, lay out, record, open, work, and maintain county roads which are petitioned for by freeholders. Guideposts shall be erected.
- (3) Each board shall discontinue or abandon county roads when freeholders properly petition therefor.

1 (4) Each board may, in its discretion, do whatever may be necessary for the best interest of the county roads and the road districts.

(5) Each board shall make reports relating to roads 5 under its supervision which are requested by the department of highways.

7 (6) Each board shall maintain a complete inventory, updated at least once annually, of all public roads and ways in the county. Included in the inventory shall be maps showing the location of all public roads and ways and indicating the length, width, and ownership of the right-of-way and the ownership status of the right-of-way (whether deeded, adjudicated, prescriptive, or other)."

Section 2. Notwithtanding section 43-517, there is no additional financing provided by this act because the costs of preparing a road inventory is considered a part of the commissioners normal operating costs.
