7	The moneys shall be provided to the treasurers of the

10	conventions in which candidates for president of the United
11	States are nominated. The treasurers of the respective
12	state parties must provide a detailed accounting of the
13	expenditure of these funds to the state treasurer by
14	December 31 of each presidential year."
