11 Section 1. Section 61-112.1, R.C.M. 1947, is amended 12 to read as follows:

"61-112.1. Destruction of property by person under 13--liability of parents for. Any municipal corporation, county, city, town, school district or department of the state of Montana, or any person, or any religious organization whether incorporated or unincorporated, shall be is entitled to recover damages in a civil action in an amount not to exceed three-nundred-dellars-(\$300.00) one thousand dollars (\$1000) in a court of competent jurisdiction from the parents of any person under the age of eighteen (18) years, living with the parents, who shall maliciously or willfully: (1) destroy destroys property, real, personal, or mixed, belonging to such municipal corporation, county, city, town, school district, er
