 13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

14 Section 1. Section 66-1514, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to
 15 read as follows:

16 "66-1514. Restrictions upon sale or prescription of
 17 opiates--coding of prescriptions prohibited--refilling
 18 prescriptions. It shall be unlawful for any physician to
 19 sell, or give to, or prescribe for any person any opium,
 20 morphine, alkaloid-cocaine, or alpha or beta eucaine, or
 21 codeine or heroin, or any derivative, mixture or preparation
 22 of any of them, except to a patient believed in good faith
 23 to require the same for medical use, and in quantities
 24 proportioned to the needs of such patients.

25 A prescription must be so written that it can be

1 compounded by any registered pharmacist. The coding of any
 2 prescription is a violation of this act. A prescription
 3 marked "non repetatur," "non rep" or "N. R." cannot be
 4 refilled. A prescription marked to be refilled by a
 5 specified amount may be filled by any registered pharmacist
 6 the number of times marked on the prescription. A

10 Section 2. There is a new R.C.M. section numbered

 16 separate offense. Penalties shall be as prescribed in
