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If the election on any additional levy for the general 3 fund is approved by a majority vote of those electors voting 4 at such election, the proposition shall carry and the ŝ trustees may use any portion or all of the authorized amount 6 in adopting the preliminary general fund budget. The 7 trustees shall certify the additional levy amount authorized 8 by such a special election on the budget form that is 9 submitted to the county superintendent and the county 10 commissioners shall levy such number of mills on the taxable 11 value of all taxable property within the district as 12 prescribed in section 75-6926, as are required to raise the 13 14 amount of such additional levy.

In compliance with a written request received <u>February 11, 1975</u>, 19 <u>,</u> there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for <u>House Bill 334</u> <u>pursuant to Chapter 53, Laws of Montana, 1965</u>. Thirty-Ninth Legislative Assembly. Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 334 is an act to eliminate the current budget limitation of 112% of the preceding year's budget for school districts. The bill would have an immediate effective date.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. The Foundation Program will remain at the current level through the 1975-77 biennium.

2. Average number belonging will not increase.

FISCAL IMPACT:

With no limitation on General Fund budgets, it is not possible to estimate the amount of funding required under House Bill 334. However, if the Foundation Program is not increased, or does not at least match inflationary increases, local taxes would have to be increased to raise the necessary funds.

Every one percent increase in general fund budget over 112% of the preceding year's budget would require additional local funds of \$1.98 million in FY 76 and \$2.22 million in FY 77.
