INTRODUCED BY (, Mend 1 2 3 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO SUBMIT TO THE 4 QUALIFIFED ELECTORS OF MONTANA AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE X, 5 6 SECTION 9 OF THE MONTANA CONSTITUTION TO PROVIDE FOR AN RLECTED NONPARTISAN COMMISSIONER OF HIGHER EDUCATION." 7 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA: 9 Section 1. Article X, section 9 of the Montana 10 Constitution is amended to read as follows: 11 "Section 9. Boards of education. (1) There is a state 12 13 board of education composed of the board of regents of higher education and the board of public education. It is 14 responsible for long-range planning, and for coordinating 15 16 and evaluating policies and programs for the state's educational systems. It shall submit unified budget 17 requests. A tie vote at any meeting may be broken by the 18 governor, who is an ex officio member of each component 19 20 board. (2) (a) The government and control of the Montana 21 university system is vested in a board of regents of higher 22 education which shall have full power, responsibility, and 23 authority to supervise, coordinate, manage and control the 24 Montana university system and shall supervise and coordinate 25

other public educational institutions assigned by law. Т (b) The board consists of seven members appointed by 2 the governor, and confirmed by the senate, to overlapping 3 terms, as provided by law. The governor and superintendent 5 of public instruction are ex officio non-voting members of б the board. 7 (c)--The-board-shall-appoint-a-commissioner--of--higher 8 education-and-prescribe-his-term-and-duties-(c) A nonpartisan commissioner of higher education 9 shall be elected to a four (4) year term by the qualified 10 electors at a general election provided by law. The 11 commissioner of higher education shall report to the board 12 13 of regents, but shall have such qualifications, duties, and 14 compensation as provided by law. 15 (d) The funds and appropriations under the control of 16 the board of regents are subject to the same audit 17 provisions as are all other state funds. 18 (3) (a) There is a board of public education to 19 exercise general supervision over the public school system 20 and such other public educational institutions as may be 21 assigned by law. Other duties of the board shall be provided 22 by law. 23 (b) The board consists of seven members appointed by 24 the governor, and confirmed by the senate, to overlapping 25 terms as provided by law.  instruction shall be ex officio non-voting members of the
 board."

4 Section 2. When this amendment is submitted to the 5 qualified electors of Montana, there shall be printed on the 6 ballot the full title and section 1 of this act and the 7 following words:

> For an elected nonpartisan commissioner of higher education.

Against an elected nonpartisan commissioner
of higher education."

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
