Section 43-723, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to 10 read as follows: A11 11 \*43-723. Number of interns--where from. institutions referred to in section 2+43-721+ may have at 12 least one three (3) intern interns. An-additional-five--{5} 13 positions--may--be-chosen-from-applications-submitted-to-the 14 legislative-council. If applicants are available Eastern 15 Montana College may have an additional four (4) interns for 16 a total of seven (7) and Montana State University and the 17 University of Montana each may have seven (7) additional 18 interns for a total of ten (10). If any of the institutions 19 do not take advantage of the number of vacancies in the 20 program, the vacant openings shall be assigned equitably to 21 the other institutions." 22 Section 2. Section 43-726, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to 23 24 read as follows: "43-726. Assignment of interns. Each legislative 25

intern is assigned to a legislator by the legislative 1 2 council. Legislative interns shall be assigned as follows: 3 each committee chairman who chooses may have an intern assigned to him. The remaining interns shall be assigned on ۸ 5 a shared-assistance basis with a ratio of approximately one 6 (1) intern to three (3) legislators, determined by the 7 number of legislators choosing to participate in the я program." 9 Section 3. Section 43-728, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to 10 read as follows: 11 "43-728. Interns responsible to sponsor. Each 12 legislative intern is directly responsible to his or her 13 legislator, or legislators as the case may be." 14 Section 4. Section 43-729, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to 15 read as follows: 16 "43-729. Program not mandatory. An institution of 17 higher learning may choose not to participate in the 18 legislative intern program. If an institution chooses to 19 participate, it shall grant at least ten (10) guarter hour 20 credits in political science, sociology, or independent 21 study, subject to those validation requirements the 22 institution imposes, including a certification of 23 satisfactory service by the legislative council." 24 Section 5. Section 43-730, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to read as follows: 25

1 "43-730. Funding not obligatory. The legislature shall not, under any condition, because of this act, be obligated to fund this internship program. <u>Cases of distinct need for</u> <u>financial assistance may be handled by the involved</u> <u>institution.</u>"
