BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 Section 1. Section 11-1832, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to 11 read as follows:

"11-1832. Minimum wage of police in first and second class cities. (1) After July 1, 1973 1975, each duly confirmed member of a police department of cities of the first class of the state of Montana is entitled to a minimum wage for a daily service of eight (8) hours' work, of at least six hundred dollars (\$600) minimum per month for the first year of service, and thereafter of at least six hundred dollars (\$600) minimum a month plus one-per-cent (1%) two percent (2%) of the minimum base monthly salary of six hundred dollars (\$600) for each additional year service up to and including the twentieth year of additional service. After July 1, 1973 1975, each duly confirmed member of a police department of cities of the second class of the

state of Montana is entitled to a minimum wace for a daily

- service of eight (8) hours' work, of at least six hundred
- 2 dollars (\$600) minimum per month for the first year of
- 3 service, and thereafter of at least six hundred dollars
- 4 (\$600) minimum per month plus ene-per-cent-(1%) two percent
- 5 (2%) of the minimum base monthly salary of six hundred
- 6 dollars (\$600) for each additional year service up to and
- 7 including the twentieth year of additional service."
