16	appointments shall be made by the governor in accordance
17	with section 82A-110.
18	(2) The council shall consist of five (5) persons,
19	including a person formerly convicted of a felony who has
20	not been under the supervision of any correctional or
21	probation authority for at least five (5) years. The other
