 12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
 13 Section 1. Section 82A-1303, R.C.M. 1947, is amended
 14 to read as follows:
 15 "82A-1303. Board of livestock -- composition. (1)
 16 There is a board of livestock.
 17 (2) The board consists of ~~six-(6)~~ seven (7) members
 18 appointed by the governor with the consent of the senate. A
 19 ~~member--shall--be--a--resident--of--this--state--and--the--owner--of~~
 20 ~~cattle,--sheep,--or--horses--in--this--state.~~ Each member shall be
 21 a resident of the state and an active livestock producer. A
 22 member shall be appointed upon the recommendation of the
 23 related industry and shall have the following
 24 qualifications:
 25 (a) two (2) are cattle producers, one (1) from each

1 congressional district within the state;
 2 (b) one (1) is a dairy producer representing the dairy
 3 and poultry industry;
 4 (c) one (1) is a swine producer;
 5 (d) one (1) is a sheep producer;
 6 (e) one (1) is an independent livestock feeder; and

 25 appoint as a new member, or as a replacement, a person

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1 qualified under the provisions of section 82A-1303 and not
