8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 Section 1. Section 32-2119, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to
 10 read as follows:

11 "32-2119. Official traffic-control devices --
 12 traffic-control signal -- railroad sign or signal -- flag
 13 person -- flag car. (a) Official Traffic-control Devices.

14 All signs, signals, markings, and devices not inconsistent
 15 with this act placed or erected by authority of a public
 16 body or official having jurisdiction, for the purpose of
 17 regulating, warning, or guiding traffic.

18 (b) Traffic-control Signal. Any device, whether
 19 manually, electrically, or mechanically operated, by which
 20 traffic is alternately directed to stop and to proceed.

21 (c) Railroad Sign or Signal. Any sign, signal, or
 22 device erected by authority of a public body or official or
 23 by a railroad and intended to give notice of the presence of
 24 railroad tracks or the approach of a railroad train.

25 (d) Flag person. Any person who directs, controls or

1 alters the normal flow of vehicular traffic upon a street or
 2 highway as a result of a vehicular traffic hazard then
 3 present on that street or highway. This person, except a
 4 uniformed traffic enforcement officer exercising his duty as
 5 a result of a planned vehicular traffic hazard, shall be
 6 equipped as required by the rules and regulations of the
 7 Montana department of highways.

8 (e) Flag car. Any vehicle equipped as required by law
 9 or Montana department of highways regulations to warn or
 10 guide vehicular traffic."

SECOND READING

This person, except a uniformed traffic enforcement officer exercising his duty as a result of a planned vehicular traffic hazard, shall be equipped as required by the rules and regulations of the Montana department of highways.
