Section 1. Cancellation of registrations. (1) In all counties within the state of Montana, the county clerk and ex officio "registrar" shall, within five (5) days after the first day of August, 1975, cancel all registrations of electors in the county and destroy all "registry cards" and "affidavits", executed and signed by any elector for the purpose of registration.
