(1) at Mountain View school, Pine Hills school, or other juvenile facility maintained by the department, for children who have been adjudicated delinquent by the tribal court; subject to the provisions of Title 80, chapter 22; or

(2) at the Montana children's center for children who have been found by the tribal court to be dependent and neglected, subject to the provisions of Title 80, chapter

21.
