10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA: 11 Section 1. Section 75-6905, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to 12 read as follows:

"75-6905. Maximum-general-fund-budget-without-a-voted-13 levy schedules for elementary and high schools. The total 14 amount of the general fund budget of any district shall not 15 be greater than the general fund budget amount specified in 16 the following schedules, except when a district has adopted 17 an emergency general fund budget under the provisions of 18 section 75-6727 or when a district has voted an additional 19 levy under the provisions of section 75-6923. 20

1 (19) The general fund budget amount for an approved and 2 accredited junior high school shall be prorated between the 3 elementary district general fund budget and the high school 4 district general fund budget in the following manner:

(a) determine the per-ANB schedule amount for the 5 school, as defined by this section, from the high school 6 7 schedule;

8 (b) calculate the ANB for the regularly enrolled 9 full-time pupils enrolled in the seventh (7th) and eighth 10 (8th) grades of the junior high school;

11 (c) multiply the per-ANB schedule amount determined in 12 subsection (a) by the ANB calculated in subsection (b) to determine the authorized general fund budget amount which 13 14 shall be available for the elementary district general fund 15 budget; and

16 (d) subtract the amount determined in subsection (c) 17 from the total authorized general fund budget amount for the 18 school to determine the authorized general fund budget 19 amount which shall be available for the high school district 20 general fund budget.

The general fund budget amount determined for each 21 22 school of a district under the schedules provided in this 23 section shall be totaled to determine the maximum-general-fund-budget-without-a-voted-levy for 24 such 25 district.

1 (20) For the purpose of establishing the maximum budget 2 without a vote amount for current year special education ٦ program for a school district, the superintendent of public instruction will determine the total estimated cost of the 4 special education program for the school district on the 5 basis of a special education program budget submitted by the 6 district. The budget will be prepared on forms provided by 7 the superintendent of public instruction and will set out 8 9 for each program

10 (a) the estimated allowable costs associated with 11 operating the program where allowable costs are as defined 12 in section 75-7813.1;

13 (b) the number of pupils expected to be enrolled in 14 the program; and

15 (c) any other data required by the superintendent of 16 public instruction for budget justification purposes and to 17 administer the provisions of this act. The total amount of allowable costs approved by the superintendent of public 18 19 instruction shall he the special education 20 maximum-budget-without-a-vote amount for current year 21 special education program purposes. The total amount of 22 allowable costs that are approved for the special education 23 budget shall not, under any condition, be less than the 24 maximum-budget-without-a-vote amount for one regular ANB for 25 each special full-time pupil in the school district.

1 (21) If a special education program is implemented or 2 expanded during a given school term too late to be included 3 in the determination of the district 4 maximum-budget-without-a-vote for the school year as 5 prescribed in this chapter, then subject to the approval of 6 the program by the superintendent, under the emergency 7 budget provisions of section 75-6723 (5), allowable costs 8 approved under the budgeting provisions of section 75-6905 9 (20) for the operation of the program during the given year 10 may be added to the maximum-budget-without-a-vote amount for 11 special education for the subsequent school year. Such costs 12 must be recorded as "previous year special education 13 expenses" in the school district budget for the subsequent 14 school year.

15 (22) The sum of the previous year special education 16 expenses as defined in subsection (21) above, and the 17 maximum-budget-without-a-vote for current year special 18 education as defined in subsection (20) shall be the special 19 education budget for accounting purposes.

The maximum-budget-without-a-vote for special education will be added to the maximum-budget-without-a-vote of the regular program ANB defined in sections 75-6902 and 75-6903 to obtain the total maximum-budget-without-a-vote for the district."

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act to increase the maximum-General-Fund-budget-without-a-voted-levy schedules for elementary and high schools by an average of 13.7% each year of the new biennium.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. The average number belonging (ANB) will remain at the same level as in FY 75.

2. Special education cost will remain at current level.

3. The state's taxable valuation will increase at a rate of 6% per year.

CONCLUSION:

If House Bill 516 with the proposed amendments is enacted and the level of General Fund support is as contained in the executive budget, a statewide property levy of 4.7 mills will be required in FY 76, and a statewide levy of 13.0 mills will be required in FY 77. These levies would be reduced on a dollar for dollar basis for every additional dollar of General Fund money (over the amount in the executive budget) appropriated for Foundation Program support).

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. The average number belonging (ANB) will remain at the same level as in FY75.
- 2. Special education cost will remain at current level.
- 3. The state's taxable valuation will increase at a rate of 6% per year.
- 4. Local permissive levies will raise \$16.38 million in FY76 and \$17.36 million in FY77.
- 5. The statewide total General Fund budgets are projected to be \$189.75 for FY76 and \$202.40 million for FY77.

In compliance with a written request received <u>Feb.1</u>, 19 75, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for <u>House Bill 516</u> pursuant to Chapter 53, Laws of Montana, 1965 - Thirty-Ninth Legislative Assembly.

Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

LOCAL IMPACT:

If House Bill 516 is enacted, the local requirement for permissive levy funding will not be significantly affected, except in a few wealthy districts, because all but the wealthiest districts now levy the full 9 mills for elementary school support, and 6 mills for high school support. However, the increases in foundation program and permissive levy amounts represent funding that would otherwise have to be sought at the local levy through voted levies on local property.

CONCLUSIONS:

State Impact. If House Bill 516 is enacted, the amount of General Fund support required to fully fund the Foundation Program will be increased by \$65.39 million during the 1975-77 biennium. The statewide property tax levy required to fund the state share of the permissive levy in FY76 will be 13.43 mills, an increase of 4.87 mills over the levy required under the existing law, and in FY77 will be 15.40 mills, an increase of 7.69 mills over the levy required under the existing law.

16 (20) For the purpose of establishing the maximum-budget 17 -without-a-vote amount for current year special education program for a school district, the superintendent of public 18 19 instruction will determine the total estimated cost of the 20 special education program for the school district on the 21 basis of a special education program budget submitted by the 22 district. The budget will be prepared on forms provided by 23 the superintendent of public instruction and will set out 24 for each program

5 (c) any other data required by the superintendent of 6 public instruction for budget justification purposes and to administer the provisions of this act. The total amount of 7 8 allowable costs approved by the superintendent of public 9 instruction shall be the special education 10 maximum-budget-without-a-vote amount for current year 11 special education program purposes. The total amount of allowable costs that are approved for the special education 12 13 budget shall not, under any condition, be less than the 14 maximum-budget-without-a-vote amount for one regular ANB for 15 each special full-time pupil in the school district.

(21) If a special education program is implemented or 16 17 expanded during a given school term too late to be included the 18 in determination of district the 19 maximum-budget-without-a-vote for the school year as 20 prescribed in this chapter, then subject to the approval of 21 the program by the superintendent, under the emergency 22 budget provisions of section 75-6723 (5), allowable costs 23 approved under the budgeting provisions of section 75-6905 24 (20) for the operation of the program during the given year 25 may be added to the maximum-budget-without-a-vote amount for

10 The maximum-budget-without-a-vote for special education 11 will be added to the maximum-budget-without-a-vote of the 12 regular program ANB defined in sections 75-6902 and 75-6903 13 to obtain the total maximum-budget-without-a-vote for the 14 district."
